Mr. Henikman discussed benchmark assessments for ELA. 3rd grade completed a Food Truck Project where they were independent in the creation and pricing of their trucks. Anna discussed yearbooks are in. There are a few leftover for sale. This year Anna lead a Yearbook Club through community schools allowing students to actively participate in designing the yearbook. The yearbook cover was also designed by a student.

CFSD Foundation: Tatiana Johnson discussed Teacher of the Year recognizing Dr. Florek. The foundation raised \$82,000.00 which was short of their goal including less sponsorships. The budget is \$100,000.00 in order to gift the district to use for teachers. They are recruiting board members to meet the 1st Tuesday of every month at 5:30 pm.

Community Schools: Autumn discussed next year CARE will have themed rooms and likely wont be separated by grades. The rooms will be redesigned as the toys are outdated with what the kids would like to play with. Autumn would like more books and games. This year an irrigation was built for the garden which will allow the garden to be incorporated into cooking classes next year. Autumn is considering building a chicken coop that could house the chickens that are hatched during kindergarten. Summer camp registration is from June 3rd to July 19th. The camp will be held at Catalina Foothills High School with summer outdoor programs available for 3rd to 8th graders.
