Principals Report:

Mrs. Herfkens discussed civic observation month that is mandated by the state and must be grade appropriate. The lessons will include 9/11, Constitution Day and Sanda Day O'Conner Day. Alex will incorporate these into Wonder Wednesdays on the morning announcements.

The first Spirit Assembly of the year will be held on October 4th and will include awards and a school song from Mr. Diamond. Any scouts that would like to be involved for the flag ceremony are welcome.

Last week estimates were conducted for shade placements on outdoor areas and the basketball courts.

We received \$1,000.00 from the Zuckerman fund which was unexpected and appreciated to add to our budget.

Mrs. Herfkens is requesting parents to have a sign with students name on it for pickup in the car line. Car line is the preferred pick up option as it limits entry to out front and the bus bay. She also discussed emergency plans that are in place for the school. She reviewed the plans and will update any changes as needed and will continue to assess communication during any emergencies.

Teacher Appreciation Month: Today was a yogurt bar. All teacher appreciation lunches will now be on FFO meeting days.

Jacqui discussed the upcoming Picnic Social this Saturday September 14th from 5-7pm. We are still in need of backyard games like jumbo Jenga or Connect 4 and water toys.

Anna discussed Coyote Cash Kickoff. We are currently shy of \$9,000.00 and the goal is \$15,000.00. There is a contest between grades for a popcorn and Eegee's party that ends on September 25th.

Canyon Boo this year will include Book Fair and the Silent Auction. There will be classroom parents requesting donations from each class to make a classroom basket to be placed up for auction. We are requesting the value of these baskets to be limited to \$400.00. If the basket exceeds this, items may be separated to make an additional basket. This allows the FFO to stretch earnings for the school. Every child will receive a designated blue bag for candy and outside bags will not be permitted. This is to control the amount of candy that is given out due to limited quantities donated and additionally purchased by the FFO. Book Fair will begin at Canyon Boo and will carry into the next school week. Scholastic prefers E-Wallet and credit card purchases.

Community Schools: CARE will have a Haunted House again during Canyon Boo. Second quarter classes will begin after Fall Break. Registration opens on 10/1. There is a suggested schedule posted for voting by parents on ParentVue. There will be full day care during Fall Break at Ventana Vista Elementary. There will also be outdoor field trips to San Pedro, Mr. Lemmon and a Salt River campout that will be open to grades 3-7.

Community Schools will host childcare for all CFSD elementary students at Manzanita Elementary for any parents that would like to attend Tapas for Teachers.

Anna discussed the cover contest for the yearbook. All information including rules has been posted on ParentVue and around campus. The deadline is 10/4 and will be voted on by staff and SAB students. The link to purchase the yearbook and 5th grade pridelines is available on the FFO website www.canyonviewffo.org. Pridelines are limited to 2 per student.

Dine Out: There will not be a dine out this month as we are having the Picnic Social with food trucks. Last months dine out at Bear Canyon Pizza earned the FFO \$426.00.
